

**JACKSBORO PLANNING COMMISSION
JANUARY 4, 2007
6:00 P.M.**

The Jacksboro Planning Commission met in regular session Thursday, January 4, 2007 at 6:00 p.m.

Present: Weaver, Cunningham, Forstner, Burden and Leach.

Also present was Gary Byrd, Building Inspector, Midge Jessiman, State Planning Office, Kenny Baird with Rollin Hills Subdivision and First Baptist Church of Jacksboro.

Motion made by Forstner second by Weaver to approve previous minutes. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Weaver second by Leach to approve the 30 X 50 Masonry and Steel addition onto the existing Family Life Center for the First Baptist Church of Jacksboro, located on Main Street. All present voted yes.

Mr. Marlow was not present, no action taken.

Kenny Baird was present to ask planning commission to take over the road in Rollin Hills Subdivision. The subdivision has been in Jacksboro for over three (3) years. Motion made by Leach second by Burden to past this request to the Jacksboro City Council for approval on the bases of L.E. Shelton – Department Head over the Street Department and Gary Byrd, Building Inspector’s approval. All present voted yes.

Mayor Jack Cannon was present to discuss the egress and ingress of the New Campbell County Jail. One entrance only was the agreement. Agreement has not been met. Motion made by Forstner second by Weaver to close one of the entrance’s going into the parking lot of the New Jail (June 2005 minutes) and to fix the sidewalk on Main Street and to remove the dumpster off of Kentucky Street. Motion made by Forstner second by Weaver to have City Attorney notify Rusty Orick of the Jail Committee of these conditions, that they are not in compliance. All present voted yes.

Mayor Jack Cannon brought to planning commission’s attention the road in front of the Spur Station and First Volunteer Bank. The Mayor is concerned of the condition of the road. The Mayor requested Eddie Cunningham to help look at the road for modernization of the road. Motion made by Forstner second by Leach to approve this request from the Mayor. All present voted yes.

Mayor Jack Cannon also brought to planning commission's attention the condition of Island Ford Road in Jacksboro. The Mayor request Eddie Cunningham to look at the road to help make changes to widen the road. Motion made by Forstner second by Leach to approve the request from the Mayor. All present voted yes.

Gary Byrd, Building Inspector, was present to discuss the trailer that was in the parking lot of the new jail. The trailer was moved when paving of the parking lot was done. The trailer is near Paris Nance Road, the trailer does meet all setbacks. Motion made by Forstner second by Burden to approve Gary Byrd to notify the Jail Committee to come to Planning Commission to discuss the trailer, no roads are allowed into the trailer and the Jail Committee has to have approval from the Planning Commission. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Weaver second by Cunningham to ask council for a \$25.00 raise. Vote: Weaver and Cunningham – yes. Forstner – no. Burden and Leach – abstained.

Motion made by Weaver second by Cunningham to adjourn. All present voted yes.
