**The Jacksboro Planning Commission met in regular session Thursday, June 2, 2011 at 6:20 p.m.**

**Motion made by Forstner second by Connor to approve previous minutes. All present voted yes. (Minutes 5-5-11).**

**Stan Marlow was present to request final approval of the Campbell County Justice Center. The old jail will be tore down and the new jail will be built in it place. The Campbell County Justice Center will be three (3) stories which include the basement. If there is any water problems the Campbell County Justice Center will be responsible. All setbacks are met. Utilities, drainage and 2,5,10 year storm event plans were turned in. Also there was discussion of the pile of dirt near Paris Nance Road, Campbell County Justice Center said it would be removed, planning commission was concerned with the water runoff and mud running onto the road. Mr. Heath requested a silk fence to be put up and for Stan Marlow to look at it occasionally to make sure no mud is going onto the street. Motion made by Heath second by Cunningham to approve the Alternate Site Grading & Erosion Control Plan and Alternate Site Drainage Plan dated 03-07-2011. Vote: Heath, Forstner and Cunningham – yes. Mr. Connor – no. Campbell County Justice Center was approved.**

**Martin Daniel requested to be added to July's agenda, planning commission requested the City Attorney Stephen Hurst to be present at this meeting.**

**Motion made by Forstner second by Heath to adjourn. All present voted yes.**
