The Board of Mayor and Aldermen met in regular session on Monday, December 16, 2002 at 5:25 P.M.

Present: Aldermen Nelson, Shelton, Cannon, Green, Mayor Higdon

Motion made by Shelton second by Cannon to approve the previous minutes. All present voted yes.

Ms. Claudia Angel was present voicing a concern about several units at Bluff Springs Apartments being flooded from a sewer problem.

Following the discussion concerning the problem motion made by Green second by Nelson to approve the City Attorney Steve Hurst contacting Mr. Frank Wallace of the CJUC and Mr. R.L. Ayers, owner of the apartments, concerning the sewer problem. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Shelton second by Higdon to approve continuing employment of Jimmy Parks and David Muse. Vote: Aldermen Nelson, Cannon, Green – no Alderwoman Shelton and Mayor Higdon – yes.

Upon the approval from the Mayor, Jimmy Parks and David Muse continued to work hours for the Town of Jacksboro although Council had terminated their positions. Motion made by Cannon second by Shelton to pay Jimmy Parks and David Muse for hours worked from November 8th through December 4th. Vote: Aldermen Nelson and Green – no Aldermen Cannon, Shelton Mayor Higdon – yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to accept the street in Arrowhead Subdivision as a city street. All present voted yes.

Upon approval of Planning Commission, motion made by Cannon second by Green to approve John Davenport combining(6) lots, in Perkins Subdivision, to make one large lot. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to approve a site plan submitted by John Davenport to build a commercial building 125 feet x 65 feet . All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to approve pay request #3 from B&D Construction Company. All present voted yes.

Mayor Higdon opened the one bid received from Tennessee Asphalt for striping the parking spaces on Main Street in amount of \$847.00

Alderman Nelson suggested to wait on accepting the bid and made a motion to advertise for bid to strip the center lines on Main Street and turning lanes second by Cannon. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to request assistance from the Campbell County Road Superintendent, in having the center lines striped. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Nelson to approve a request from the Librarian to purchase books for the library, the cost to be \$617.85. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to approve the library copy machine being repaired and cost to be taken from the library fines and copies. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Shelton second by Higdon to approve the installation of a streetlight on Indian Mound Circle for Mr. Stallings and a light for Mr. Partin on Highland Drive. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Shelton to increase Bryan Queener and Vernon Young to 29 ½ hours per week. All present voted yes.

. Motion made by Shelton second by Higdon to reinstate Keith Hatfield as the city attorney. Vote: Nelson and Green – no Cannon – pass Shelton and Higdon yes.

In July, 2002 Mayor Higdon made the appointment of Steve Hurst as the city attorney, motion made by Nelson second by Green to approve the appointment of Mr. Hurst, as the city attorney. Vote: Nelson and Green – yes Cannon – pass Shelton and Higdon – no

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to approve the street department request to purchase tools, approximate cost of \$319.98. Vote: Nelson, Cannon, Green, Mayor Higdon – yes Shelton – no

Motion made by Shelton second by Higdon to approve expenditures. Vote: Nelson and Green – pass Cannon, Shelton and Mayor Higdon – yes.

Motion made by Green to adjourn.
