

Board of Mayor and Aldermen Meeting  
March 4, 2004

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen met in regular session on Thursday, March 4, 2004 at 7:00 P.M.

Present: Aldermen Burrell, Shelton, Cannon, Green and Mayor Higdon.

Motion made by Cannon second by Shelton to approve previous minutes. All present voted yes.

Nancy Ferra, Delmus Gaylor and Julie Turner were present concerning the rezoning proposed on West Street.

Ms. Benson with the Senior Citizens Center was present informing Council of the activities and services provided by the Center and requested a donation to assist with the cost.

Motion made by Burrell second by Higdon to include the Senior Citizens Center on the list for donations in the fiscal year budget 2004-05. All present voted yes.

Mayor Higdon called a 5 minute recess.

Meeting called back to order with the same members present.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to approve on the second and final reading of Ordinance #89-Rezoning property on West Street from a R-2 to a B-2 district. Vote: Burrell,Cannon,Green - yes Shelton - pass Mayor Higdon- no

Mayor Higdon opened bids received for the road repairs on Butter & Egg Road.

Motion made by Cannon second by Shelton to approve IRTEC inspecting the bids and make a recommendation. All present voted yes.

Mayor Higdon opened the bids received for the purchase of street signs.

Motion made by Green second by Cannon to approve the low bid. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Shelton second by Cannon to approve Vernon Young as a full time fireman @\$7.00 per hour. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Shelton to approve Ben Marlow as a part time fireman @\$6.00 per hour and Daniel Lawson as an auxiliary fireman. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to approve the CJUC making repairs to correct the water problem on Highland Drive the cost of the project will be \$7820.00 All present voted yes and Mr. Burrell stating his conflict of interest.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to request the CJUC to address the water problem on Indian Mound Circle near the PM Realty Office. All present voted yes and Mr. Burrell stating his conflict of interest.

Motion made by Shelton second by Cannon to approve a Police & Fire Department calendar program for 2005 from Law Enforcement Press at no cost to the town. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to approve ratifying the decision to place Fireman Travis Shelton on leave without pay. Vote: Burrell,Cannon,Green, Mayor Higdon yes Shelton- pass due to conflict of interest.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to approve Resolution #266- for the financing of construction of the water storage tank. Vote: Burrell,Cannon,Shelton,Green yes Mayor Higdon passed due to conflict of interest.

City Attorney Stephen Hurst advised Council that due to the Mayor passing due to a conflict of interest that he would recommend that Council designate the Vice Mayor to sign the paperwork.

Motion made by Green second by Burrell to designate the Vice Mayor to sign the paperwork for Resolution #266. Vote: Burrell,Cannon,Shelton,Green yes Mayor Higdon passed due to conflict of interest.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to approve installing a grate at a driveway on Island Ford Road to prevent water from running onto the property owned by C.R. Aiken the cost of the grate is approximately \$850.00 All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Shelton to approve the expenditures. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to approve Resolution #267-encouraging the 103<sup>rd</sup> General Assembly to protect jobs in Tennessee by supporting workers' compensation reform. Vote: Burrell,Cannon,Green, Mayor Higdon yes Shelton pass.

Motion made by Green to adjourn.
