

Board of Mayor and Aldermen Meeting  
April 1, 2004

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen met in regular session on Thursday, April 1, 2004  
At 7:00 p.m.

Present: Aldermen Burrell, Shelton, Cannon, Green  
Absent: Mayor Higdon

In the absence of the Mayor, Vice Mayor Jack Cannon presided at the meeting.

Motion made by Green second by Burrell to approve the previous minutes. All present voted yes.

June Forstner representing the Jacksboro Cemetery Committee presented a thank you to the Council for a donation to the cemetery fund.

Vice Mayor Cannon presented a certificate to the Fire Department from the State Fire Marshal's Office declaring the department as a duly recognized fire department.

Motion made by Green second by Shelton to approve the J.D. Anderson Contracting bid for the Butter and Egg Road Project. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Shelton to approve Resolution No. 265 for the HOME Grant. All present voted yes.

Paul Baxter presented a proposal for discussion of by-pass routes around Jacksboro and Caryville.

Town of Caryville Councilmembers Wade Lawson and David Chambers were present to discuss recreation. A joint workshop meeting of the Town of Caryville and the Town of Jacksboro is to be held for further discussion of a recreation program.

Motion made by Green second by Burrell to approve the new contribution rate of 6.2% for the Tennessee Consolidated Retirement System. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Burrell to approve purchasing 2 street name signs and 2 school zone signs. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burrell second by Green to approve 2 from the street, police and fire departments to attend a chemical spill response training class on April 21<sup>st</sup>. All present voted yes.

Alderman Burrell ask several questions concerning lawsuits filed against the Town and how can the Town provide for the safety of the employees. City Attorney Steve Hurst advised Council as for the safety of the employees that an injunction could be issued to prevent any one from interfering with an employee while on the job. Alderman Burrell also ask if there is an active Volunteer Fire Department and Fire Chief Shayne Green answered no.

Motion made by Burrell second by Green to approve repairing the oil line on the sanitation truck. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Shelton second by Burrell to approve an estimate from LaFollette Tree Trimming (Hansford Hat maker)to top 6 trees and to take down 1 tree at the cost of \$900.00 (all trees located on East Street) All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burrell second by Shelton to approve expenditures and financial report. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green to adjourn.
