The Board of Mayor and Aldermen met in a rescheduled meeting on Thursday, May 13, 2004 at 7:30 P.M.

Present: Aldermen Burrell, Shelton, Cannon, Green  
Absent: Mayor Higdon

In the absence of Mayor Higdon, Vice-Mayor Cannon presided at the meeting.

Motion made by Green second by Shelton to approve previous minutes. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Shelton second by Green to approve contracts to audit with Mitchell, Emert and Hill for the fiscal year 7/1/03 – 6/30/04. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Shelton second by Burrell to approve roadblocks for the Cancer Association on May 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>. and the Shriners on 5-21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup>. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burrell second by Green to approve the low bid for recycling containers and to include lettering on the containers. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Shelton second by Burrell to approve advertising for bid to purchase a copy machine. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Shelton second by Burrell to release up request the \$500.00 donation to the Children's Center. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Shelton second by Green to approve the purchase list as presented. (see attached) All present voted yes.

Motion made by Shelton second by Green to approve a \$300.00 donation to LaFollette T-ball and Little League. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Shelton to approve paying of the remaining balance due on a vehicle confiscated by the police department; to be paid from the drug fund and to purchase lights for the vehicle. Total amount approximately 2500.00 All present voted yes.

Motion made by Shelton second by Burrell to approve the police policy as presented. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Shelton second by Green to purchase 2 or 3 signs for Donna's Diner as recommended by the planning commission. All present voted yes

Motion made by Shelton second by Green to approve purchasing additional signs from the sign grant. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Shelton to use the standard recycling color of blue for the recycling containers. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Burrell to donate \$500.00 to the Jacksboro Middle School to assist with the maintenance of the walking track; to be paid from the recreation fund. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Shelton second by Green to approve Morgan Carpenter as a library substitute. All present voted yes.

Police Chief Danny Chapman recommended that Council terminate Police Officer Greg McCloud.

Motion made by Shelton to place Officer McCloud on probation status until the June meeting to evaluate his job performance and work out any other problem. No second to motion.

Motion made by Green for the Mayor to call a Special Called Meeting on Monday, May 17, 2004, as other members could not be present on that date motion was withdrawn.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to place Officer McCloud on suspension with pay until the June meeting. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Burrell to approve the expenditures and the financial report.
