

Board of Mayor and Aldermen Meeting  
July 1, 2004

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen met in regular session on July 1, 2004 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Alderman Burrell, Shelton, Cannon, Green and Mayor Higdon.

A program was presented by the Young Marines of Campbell County including the pledge of allegiance and reciting the marine prayer.

Motion made by Green second by Burrell to approve the previous minutes. All present voted yes.

Citizens in Indian Mound Subdivision requested No Thru Truck Traffic signs be placed on Indian Mound Circle as the large trucks are causing problems for homeowners in the residential area.

Reports were submitted from the Library, Police, Fire and Street Departments.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to approve the paving of Indian Mound Circle, Hope Wier Lane and the crossover section between Gent and West Street. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Burrell to table hiring a street/sanitation worker. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Higdon to approve the fall festival including purchasing fire hats and balloons. Alderwoman Shelton will be coordinating the festival and to bring information back to Council. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Shelton second by Higdon to donate \$200.00 to the Shrine's Circus. All present voted yes except Alderman Burrell who passed.

Motion made by Cannon second by Higdon to approve Kathy Green and one police officer to attend the TIBRS Conference in September. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Shelton to approve a list of purchases for the Street Department. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Shelton to approve the City Recorder attending a workshop on July 23, 2004. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Shelton second by Cannon to approve Resolution #268- Continuing Budget. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Higdon to approve Resolution #269 concerning Capitalization and to change the \$500.00 land value to \$2500.00. All present voted yes

Motion made by Cannon second by Shelton to require department heads or their representative to attend Council meetings and to pay for their time. All present voted yes.

Police Chief Danny Chapman recommended terminating School Resource Officer Charlie Jenkins (insubordination and excessive absences). Also reported that the Principal of the Jacksboro Middle School is not satisfied

Motion made by Cannon second by Shelton to approve the recommendation of the Police Chief and to terminate Officer Charlie Jenkins. Vote: Alderman Burrell, Shelton, Cannon – yes. Alderman Green and Mayor Higdon- pass

Motion made by Cannon second by Shelton to advertise to accept applications for a School Resource Officer and to include the Jacksboro Middle School Principal when applicants are interviewed. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Higdon second by Shelton to check on the cost of welcome to Jacksboro signs. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burrell second by Higdon to approve the expenditures and financial report. Vote: Alderman Burrell, Shelton, Higdon-yes Alderman Cannon –pass Alderman Green – abstain.

Motion made by Burrell to adjourn.
