The Board of Mayor and Aldermen met in regular session on Thursday, August 5, 2004 at 7:00 P.M.

In the absence of the Mayor, Vice Mayor Jack Cannon presided at the meeting.

Motion made by Burrell second by Shelton to approve previous minutes. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burrell second by Shelton to approve upon agreement with all conditions of his pre-trial diversion and an agreement with the Town Fireman Travis Shelton returning to work as a fireman in Jerry Young's position while Mr. Young is on sick leave. Vote: Burrell and Shelton – yes Cannon-abstain Green-pass

Upon recommendation from Street Department Crew Leader motion made by Cannon second by Burrell to employ Eric Green as a street/sanitation employee. Vote: Burrell, Green and Cannon – yes Shelton pass

Motion made by Green second by Burrell to approve Librarian Margaret Southerland attending a workshop in Clinton on August 13th. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Burrell to approve the first reading of the budget for the fiscal year ending 6-3-05. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Shelton to approve Resolution #270- Budget Amendments. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burrell second by Green to approve re-submitting the same T-21 application if the current one is not approved. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Burrell to approve signing a statement of support for the Guard and Reserve. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Shelton second by Green to approve the recycling agreement prepared by the city attorney. (attached) All present voted yes.

Motion made by Shelton second by Green to approve the Recorder and Police Chief attending a workshop on August 31st. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Shelton second by Burrell to approve installing guardrail on Butter and Egg Road between Mt. View and Michael Lane upon Mr. Shelton of the street department inspecting the site to determine if a guardrail is needed. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burrell second by Shelton to approve a roadblock on August 14th for the United States Service Command. (Provides disaster relief to emergency agencies). All present voted yes.

Motion made by Shelton second by Burrell to approve an amendment change to the police policy. All present voted yes. (attached)

Motion made by Green second by Shelton to approve up to \$450.00 for repairs to the fire truck. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to approve \$141.00 to purchase sanitizer for the garbage truck and to approve the purchase of 2 tractor tires at the cost of \$661.00 All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burrell second by Green to approve employing Gregory Cox as the School Resource Officer at the Jacksboro Middle School if all requirements including physical and psychological are met. All present voted.

Motion made by Green second by Burrell to approve up to \$350.00 for repairs to the 1997 patrol car. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Burrell to approve purchasing (2) sets of tires for the police department. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Shelton second by Burrell to approve the bid received for street marking from Superior Pavement Markings, in the amount of \$2750.00. All present voted yes. (attached)

Motion made by Green second by Burrell to ask Tennessee Asphalt to give a quote on paving School Road. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burrell second by Shelton to temporarily adjust the pay of Fire Chief J.C. Miller who is acting fire chief to the same rate of the pay as the previous chief receives. Vote: Burrell and Shelton – yes Cannon-no Green- pass

Motion made by Shelton second by Green to approve expenditures and financial report.
