

**Board of Mayor and Alderman Meeting
October 6, 2005**

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen met in regular session on Thursday, October 6, 2005 at 7:00 P.M.

Present: Alderman Burden, Forstner, Green, and Mayor Cannon

Absent: Alderman Burrell

Motion made by Green second by Burden to approve the previous minutes with an amendment reflecting the bid for paving in Perkins Subdivision was for Perkins Lane and not Perkins Trail. All present voted yes.

Mayor Cannon reported to Council that the energy audit of the municipal building has been completed and a report would be sent also working on the early warning system and the Jacksboro web site is ready to go.

City Attorney Stephen Hurst reported that the Dilbeck property located on Cedar Lane that he had filed a lawsuit but Mr. Dilbeck has taken care of the problems concerning the property and recommended terminating the suit following an inspection and approval from the codes inspector.

Motion made by Cannon second by Forstner to approve terminating the lawsuit upon approval from the inspector that all violations have been addressed and to approve paying Mr. Hurst an additional fee for hours working on the lawsuit. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to approve paying \$1.00 per capita (1889) as the town's share to the Campbell County Joint Economic and Community Development Board. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Burden to approve Resolution #283 adopting the Campbell County Hazard Mitigation Plan. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burden second by Green to approve, as amended, a Use Agreement with the Campbell County Board of Education. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Burden to approve Officer Stephanie Smith as a full time officer and increase hourly pay rate to \$10.00 per hour. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to employ Robert Cardwell as a part time police officer at \$8.00 per hour. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Burden to employ James Skeans as a part time police officer at \$8.00 per hour. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve purchasing (5) push bumpers for the patrol cars. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve installing a telephone in the police chief's office. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Forstner to approve a request from the Fire Chief to donate a number of surplus items to another fire department. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Burden to approve paying the \$75.00 fee for three firemen to attend a class; if class is failed the fireman would have to pay the fee to attend a second time. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Burden to approve employing James Williford as a full time fireman at \$7.00 per hour and to employ Wayne Allen as a part time fireman at \$6.00 per hour. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to approve \$150.00 for a drain to be placed on Indian Mound Circle. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve purchases for the street department (weed killer, post puller, boots). All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burden second by Green to approve installing larger streetlights in the business areas. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Forstner to approve the fire department spending a \$400.00 donation to purchase tools. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve the librarian attending a workshop in Clinton on October 14th. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Burden to compensate Gregory Smith with three additional days in lieu of wages for the work he has done on the Jacksboro web site. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve purchasing new exit lights for the building. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Forstner to approve expenditures. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green to adjourn.
