

**Board of Mayor and Aldermen Meeting
March 2, 2006**

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen met in regular session on Thursday, March 2, 2006 at 7:00 P.M.

Present: Alderman Burden, Burrell, Forstner, Green and Mayor Cannon.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve the previous minutes. All present voted yes.

Mayor Cannon reported to council that a workshop will be held on March 27, 2006 at 6:00 P.M. for the purpose of budget preparation for fiscal year 2006-07.

Motion made by Cannon second by Burrell to proclaim March 3, 2006 as Hattie Wilson Day to commemorate her 100th birthday. All present voted yes.

Reports were submitted by the library, fire and street departments.

Motion made by Green second by Burden to approve Barney Goins Construction installing new lights at the front of the building; cost of \$880.00. All present voted yes.

Ms. Susan Emert of Mitchell, Emert & Hill, auditors for the town was present and presented the financial statements for the period ending 6/30/05. Ms. Emert reported there were no findings or recommendations to report and that the Town of Jacksboro is very good financial condition.

Motion made by Burrell second by Burden to approve purchasing (4) metal grates to be placed on Indian Mound Circle; cost of \$1200.00. All present voted yes.

Mayor Cannon requested council to consider approving an ordinance on door to door soliciting and to impose a \$10.00 fee per person. City Attorney Steve Hurst recommended requesting a model ordinance from MTAS and to include restrictions required by the town concerning door to door soliciting.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to notify the CJUC that Council is opposed to the Town of Caryville's proposed garbage collection fee for the residents of Caryville being included on the water/sewer billing of the Caryville Jacksboro Utility Commission. Vote: Alderman Burden, Forstner, Green, Mayor Cannon yes, Alderman Burrell abstain.

Following a discussion of the two phase water rate increase and the CJUC installing water and sewer lines in subdivisions a motion was made by Green second by Cannon that effective March 2, 2006 the Caryville Jacksboro Utility Commission is not to be involved with installing water and/or sewer lines in subdivision for private developers. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Cannon to amend the previous motion to state this does not apply for installing an individual water or sewer tap for a resident in a subdivision. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve expenditures and financial report. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner to adjourn.
