

Board of Mayor and Alderman Meeting
April 6, 2006

The Board of Mayor and Alderman met in regular session on Thursday, April 6, 2006 at 7:10 P.M.

Present: Alderman Burden, Green and Mayor Cannon.

Absent: Alderman Burrell and Forstner.

Motion made by Green second by Burden to approve the previous minutes. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burden second by Green to install guardrail near the curve on Station Hill Road for the safety of the residents in that area. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to approve a request from the Rescue Squad to hold a roadblock on Saturday, June 3, 2006.. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burden second by Green to approve having the garbage truck painted at the cost of \$2500.00 All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Burden to approve a contract to audit with Mitchell,Emert and Hill C.P.A. for fiscal year ending 6/30/06. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Burden to approve employing James Jefferies as a part time police officer, as recommended by Police Chief Chapman. All present voted yes.

Mayor Cannon reported to Council that the Spring Clean Up dates will be April 13th, 20th and 27th.

Motion made by Burden second by Cannon to pay the estimated cost of \$871.00 (to Mr. Nathaniel S. Whaley) for an accident that involved a city owned vehicle instead of filing a claim with the town's insurance. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Cannon to request the CJUC to review and assist with a flooding problem in Perkins Subdivision. All present voted yes.

Following a discussion of the library computer policy and the library board's amendment to lower the age to 17 and would not require parent/guardian approval motion made by Cannon second by Green to not approve the amendment and to leave the policy as written that approval is required for anyone under the age of 18. All present voted yes.

The Librarian reported that the library has been awarded free copies of 15 classic books from the We the People Bookshelf a program to encourage young people to read and understand great literature.

Motion made by Green second by Burden to approve the retirement contribution rate of 7.33% as set by the Tennessee Consolidated Retirement Commission. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Burden to approve purchasing street name signs to replace the ones that are damaged or torn down. All present voted yes.

The fire department received three (3) sets of turn out gear through a grant from Homeland Security and applied for by the Campbell County EMA; 3 additional items are needed to make the sets complete. Motion made by Green second by Burden to approve purchasing 3 pair each of gloves, helmets and hoods at the cost of \$865.60. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burden second by Cannon to approve Tennessee Fire Equipment performing flow test on the SCBA at the cost of \$35.00 each. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Burden to approve purchasing 50 smoke detectors for citizens who needs one. WalMart price for the detectors is \$4.47 each and WalMart will donate 10 detectors. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Burden to approve 1 fire department employee and 1 street department employee attending a Chemical Spill Response Training on April 19th in Knoxville. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Burden to approve expenditures and the financial report. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burden to adjourn.
