

**Board of Mayor and Alderman Meeting
May 4, 2006**

The Board of Mayor and Alderman met in regular session on Thursday, May 4, 2006 at 7:00 P.M.

Present: Alderman Burden, Burrell, Forstner, Green and Mayor Cannon.

Motion made by Burden second by Green to approve the previous minutes. All present voted yes.

Mayor Cannon reported that smoke detectors are available at the fire department for the citizens of Jacksboro who may need one.

Motion made by Green second by Forstner to approve requesting the CJUC to assist the street department with a water problem on Michael Lane and Cove Street. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Burden to approve advertising to purchase a four wheel drive pickup truck for the street department (to be delivered within a 6 week period). All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve the Mayor hiring (2) part-time employees for the summer 16 hours per week @\$7.50 per hr. to assist the street department with mowing. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Burrell to send to Planning Commission a request for rezoning on Valley Street west of Paris Nance Road. All present voted yes.

Bids were received for the sidewalk replacement and concrete entrance.

Motion made by Forstner second by Burden to approve bid received from J.D. Anderson Contracting and to include in the contract that project is to be completed by 6-30-06 and a fee for each day beyond 6-30-06 will be assessed at 1% of project cost. Vote: Burden, Forstner, Green and Mayor Cannon yes Alderman Burrell abstained.

Motion made by Green second by Forstner to advertise for bid to pave Liberty Street (from Main Street to Valley Street) and Sharp & Perkins Road. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Burrell approve resolutions to release funds for donations to the following organizations: Resolution #288 and 288-A–Jacksboro Cemetery \$3000.00, #288-B and D to Campbell County Cancer Association, #288-C to Campbell County Senior Citizens, #288-E to Shrine Circus Fund. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve the request from the street department: chain for salt spreader \$546.33, lawnmower and weed eater, brake repair on garbage truck approx. \$493.00. All present voted yes.

Fire Chief Jason Shetterly requested approval to file a 50-50 matching grant application to the Tennessee Department of Agriculture Division of Forestry.

Motion made by Burrell second by Burden to approve filing the grant application for the fire department. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burrell second by Green to include in the 2006-07 budget a \$5000.00 donation to the Campbell County Veterans Memorial Committee to assist with the expense of constructing a wall to place the names of veterans. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Burden to approve expenditures and financial report. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green to adjourn.
