

**Board of Mayor and Alderman Meeting
August 3, 2006**

The Board of Mayor and Alderman met in regular session on Thursday, August 3, 2006 at 7:00 P.M.

Present: Alderman Burden, Burrell, Forstner, Green and Mayor Cannon.

Motion made by Forstner second by Burrell to approve previous minutes. All present voted yes.

Mayor Cannon reported to Council that Paris Nance Road dedication will be Saturday, August 19th at 10:00 A.M.

Motion made by Burrell second by Burden to repair light switch on patrol car. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve employee health insurance enrollment with the State of Tennessee health plan. All present voted yes.

Reports were submitted by Library, Police, Fire, and Street Departments.

Motion made by Green second by Forstner for Mayor to obtain quotes to purchase a 4x4 pickup truck for the street department as no bids were received as per advertisement. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Burden to approve Resolution #289-Budget Amendments for the fiscal year ending 6-30-06. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Burden to advertise for bid to purchase a vehicle for police department. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Forstner to authorize the Mayor to transfer city employees from one department to another, if needed on temporary basis. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to approve (2) attending the TIBRS workshop to be held in Chattanooga. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Burden to approve purchasing ammunition for police department in-service. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burrell second by Forstner to approve request from Fire Chief to purchase items for the fire department. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve purchasing (4) tires for street department. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve Librarian attending workshop. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Burden to pay for internet access for the library in the amount of \$1680.00 and the Campbell County Library Board will reimburse 50% of the cost upon budget approval. All present voted yes.

Mayor Cannon reported that a Public Hearing will be held on Thursday, September 7, 2006 at 7:00 P.M. for re-zoning of property.

Motion made by Burrell to make some changes for a safer intersection at Liberty Street and Jacksboro Station Hill. Following a discussion of the intersection and that signs are in place as per the state recommendations motion died for lack of a second.

Motion made by Cannon second by Forstner to install guardrail on Liberty Street near the curve at the city limits (Wilson property). All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve expenditures and financial report. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner to adjourn.
