The Board of Mayor and Alderman met in regular session on Thursday, September 7, 2006 at 7:07 P.M.

Present: Alderman Burden, Burrell, Forstner, Green and Mayor Cannon.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve previous minutes. All present voted yes.

Reports were submitted from Police, Fire, Street Departments and Library.

Motion made by Cannon second by Forstner to approve a quote received from Dave Violette for painting city hall offices, meeting room, hallway and bathroom also to replace ceiling tile in the city hall offices. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to request the Caryville Jacksboro Utility Commission to assist the street department in placing tile on Mineral Springs Lane to prevent flooding problems. All present voted yes except Alderman Burrell who abstained.

Motion made by Cannon second by Forstner to approve accepting, as a city street, the road constructed by Campbell County Highway Department (Paris Nance Road), upon receiving a deed for the property from Campbell County and approved by the City Attorney. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Cannon to approve Ordinance No. 91 first reading of ordinance to rezone property from R-2 to a B-1 District. All present voted yes. (map attached)

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve Ordinance No. 92 first reading of ordinance to rezone property from R-1 to a B-2 District (David Taylor property). All present voted yes. (map attached)

Motion made by Cannon second by Forstner to approve purchasing a used in- car camera for the police department at the cost of \$850.00 All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Burrell to approve a roadblock on September 30, 2006 for the Campbell County High School. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burrell second by Forstner to approve purchasing 3 sets of tires for the Police Department. All present voted yes.

Bids were opened on August 31, 2006 for a 2007 Ford Crown Victoria Police Vehicle:

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve the bid received from Neill Sandler Ford for a 2007 Ford Crown Victoria police vehicle in the amount of \$20,791.00. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve purchasing equipment for the 2007 Ford patrol car. All present voted yes. (approximately \$5000.00)

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to approve fire department purchasing material for the fall festival and fire prevention at the cost of approximately \$400.00. All present voted yes.

The fire department has been requested to burn the house located on the corner of School Street and Appalachian Highway (Wheeler Ridenour house) and may use the house for training. Motion made by Cannon second by Forstner to approve the fire department using the house for training and then to burn. Owner is responsible for removing shingles and vinyl siding. All present voted yes except Alderman Green who abstained.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to approve fire department purchasing two trophies to present to two children at the Jacksboro Elementary School. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Forstner to approve street department purchasing 100 pounds of Ice & Snow Melt and sealer for the concrete in the front of the Municipal Building. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve auxiliary firemen working with the street department when needed, the rate of pay to be \$8.00 per hour. All present voted yes.

Following a discussion of replacing the traffic light on Main Street, Mayor Cannon requested the Police Chief to obtain specifications for light.

Motion made by Green second by Forstner to approve expenditures and financial report. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner to adjourn.
