

**Board of Mayor and Alderman Meeting  
January 4, 2007**

**The Board of Mayor and Alderman met in regular session on Thursday, January 4, 2007 at 7:15 P.M.**

**Present: Alderman Burden, Forstner, Green and Mayor Cannon.**

**Absent: Alderman Burrell**

**Motion made by Green second by Forstner to approve the previous minutes. All present voted yes.**

**Motion made by Cannon second by Burden to reimburse \$120.00 to Franklin Hatmaker, Marty Braden and Dave Violette for fees to obtain Commercial Drivers License. All present voted yes.**

**Motion made by Cannon second by Forstner to approve purchasing forty (40) feet of grated tile at the cost of \$37.00 per foot to install at two (2) driveways entering onto Main Street. This type of tile will help to prevent flooding problems during heavy rainfall. All present voted yes.**

**Motion made by Forstner second by Burden to approve \$500.00 for labor to replace ceiling tile and install insulation in the municipal building. All present voted yes.**

**Reports from departments were submitted.**

**Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve purchasing from Overbay Communications a radio with microphones at the cost of \$594.25, installation/setup and training to replace the existing radio cost of \$375.55. All present voted yes.**

**Motion made by Burden second by Green to approve James Williford stepping down from full time fireman to auxiliary, to approve Jackie Heatherly as a full time fireman @\$7.00 per hour and to approve Chris Wallen as a part time fireman, to approve sending one fireman to state fire school for certification at the cost of \$170.00 also to approve the purchase request. (Items purchased will be paid from funds donated for the department). All present voted yes.**

**Motion made by Forstner second by Green to defer to the State of Tennessee any action to be taken concerning unauthorized stream crossing of Dog Creek. Vote: Burden, Forstner, Green – yes Mayor Cannon-abstain**

**Alderwoman Forstner reported that the planning commission was requesting a \$25.00 per month pay increase also a discussion concerning the trailer that has been placed, by the County, on the corner of Main Street and Paris Nance Road. The**

placement of the trailer at this location is not in compliance with the agreement to build the new Campbell County Jail also not in compliance is the blacktopped road entrance this was a temporary entrance and was to be closed and the sidewalk replaced, by the County, upon the completion of construction of the jail.

Motion made by Cannon second by Burden to authorize City Attorney Stephen Hurst to send a letter to the County Mayor concerning the road entrance and the re-location of the trailer. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Forstner to approve the expenditures. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Burden to adjourn.
