**Board of Mayor and Alderman Meeting
July 3, 2008**

The Board of Mayor and Alderman met in regular session on Thursday, July 3, 2008 immediately following the public hearing.

Present: Aldermen Burden, Forstner, Green and Mayor Cannon.

Absent: Alderman Baird

Motion made by Green second by Fortner to approve previous minutes and workshops. All present voted yes.

Mayor Cannon reported to Council that Mr. Don Baird had resigned his position as Alderman of the Town of Jacksboro effective July 1, 2008. In his letter of resignation Mr. Baird stated his resignation is due to health issues.

Motion made by Forstner second by Burden to approve the first reading of Ordinance No. 97- Changes to the zoning map. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve selling the police department surplus video cameras to the Caryville Police Department. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Green to approve attendance to the TIBRS conference to be held in Gatlinburg in September. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Burden to approve Resolutions 300 A-B-C, donations to Campbell County Art Dept., Jacksboro Cemetery and Campbell County Cancer Society. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burden second by Forstner to approve Resolution 301-application for matching funds through the TML Safety Partners Grant. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Burden to approve \$75.00 per year cost for Police Department to have access to the Criminal Justice Web Portal, Police Chief Danny Chapman will be the administrator and Sgt. Jeremy Goins will be the assistant administrator. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burden second by Forstner to approve a policy concerning the use of the digital cameras installed in the police vehicles. Disciplinary action may be taken following a 90 day probationary period for non compliance of the policy. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burden second by Forstner to approve a request from the police department for purchase of case management files and plastic badges (for children) to approve purchasing tires, as needed and to approve Officer Skeans attending a training class which will also meet his requirement for 40 hours of in-service training. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Forstner to approve a request from the fire department to test breathing apparatus and each employee to have a FIT test performed. Total cost is \$650.00, the test will be conducted on site by King respiratory services. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Burden to approve a request from MAP (Mothers Against Predators) to conduct a rally on Friday, July 11, 2008 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on Main Street. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve expenditures and financial report. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner to adjourn.
