Motion made by Forstner second by Burden to table Resolution No. 312(prohibiting handguns in parks) until the October meeting. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burden second by Nance to approve Resolution No. 313-application for a safety grant. All present voted yes.

Mayor Cannon joined the meeting at this time.

Motion made by Burden second by Green to approve the request from the police department to replace a light bar and to purchase patches and a file cabinet. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve \$442.00 to purchase fire prevention materials. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve \$800.00 to purchase a surplus vehicle from the county to be used for animal control. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Forstner to approve library employee Gregory Smith attending a workshop on September 22, 2009. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve property owner, Doyle Huckaby placing a garage on city owned property adjacent to his property with the condition that if the town needs the land the garage would have to be removed, also the city attorney would prepare a legal document for the acceptance of this condition. All present voted yes

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve expenditures and financial report. All present voted yes.
