**Board of Mayor and Aldermen Meeting

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen met in regular session on Thursday, March 4, 2010 immediately following the public hearing.

Present: Aldermen Nance, Burden, Forstner, Green and Mayor Cannon.

Motion made by Green second by Burden to approve previous minutes. All present voted yes.

Upon recommendation of the Fire Chief, motion made by Forstner second by Burden to approve Jeffery Partin and Jeffery Fugate as auxiliary firemen. All present voted yes.

Mayor Cannon reported to Council that Librarian Margaret Southerland effective retirement date is March 13, 2010.

Motion made by Cannon second by Forstner to approve Bennie Faulkner as a substitute employee for the library, effective 3-15-10. All present voted yes.

Susan Emert with Mitchell, Emert & Hill, C.P.A. was present and presented the town's financial statements for the year ending 6-3-09. Ms. Emert reported there were no findings or recommendations to report.

Reports were submitted from each department.

Following a discussion of the Land Use Plan, motion was made by Forstner second by Nance to approve on the first reading of Ordinance No.100-Land Use Plan/Maps as approved and recommended by the Jacksboro Planning Commission. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Cannon to approve street department request to purchase four (4) tires for the recycling truck. Lowest price quote was from Doyle's Tire Shop at \$460.00. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Burden to approve police department request to purchase 100 patches at the cost of approximately \$1.88 each. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burden second by Green to approve \$250.00 for repairs for the water heater and lights at the vacant city owned building (Action Printing Building). All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burden second Forstner to approve request to purchase two State and two United States flags. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Cannon to approve First Volunteer Bank sponsoring a roadblock on March 20,2010 and April 3, 2010 for Relay for Life; roadblock to be held on Main Street. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve expenditures and financial report. All present voted yes.

Following a discussion concerning accident reports, motion made by Forstner second by Cannon to charge a fee of \$5.00 for a copy of an accident report. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner to adjourn.
