

**Board of Mayor and Aldermen Meeting
October 7, 2010**

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen met in regular session on Thursday, October 7, 2010 at 7:00 P.M.

Present: Aldermen Nance, Burden, Forstner, Green and Mayor Cannon.

Motion made by Forstner second by Burden to approve previous minutes with a correction to reflect patrol car is to be purchased from the Drug Fund. All present voted yes.

State Farm Insurance Company issued a check in the amount of \$3458.31 to Jacksboro Body Shop for damages to the 1994 Chevrolet Street Department truck; motion made by Forstner second by Green for the check to be returned to State Farm and reissued to the Town of Jacksboro. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burden second by Forstner to approve the second and final reading of Ordinance No. 101 International Building Codes. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burden second by Nance to approve street department request to purchase street signs and to replace stop signs if needed. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Nance to approve police department request for Officer Skeans to attend an Advanced Sniper Course on October 25-29 and to pay for the ammunition for Officers Starrett and Goins to attend training in Knoxville on November 9th – 11th also to purchase two shotguns at the cost of \$350.00 each. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Cannon second by Burden to approve the police department selling at public auction confiscated, seized and other miscellaneous items also to include the 1993 GMC Jimmy and the 2000 Ford police car; funds received from the auction to be included in the budget of the department from which the items came. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burden second by Forstner to purchase equipment for the 2010 Dodge Police car to be paid from the Drug Fund. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Nance to approve striping the white police car. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Burden to approve the proposal from Benefield Richters in the amount of \$6500.00 for architectural services on the Recreation Grant. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Burden to approve Stephen Carroll as an auxiliary fireman, upon recommendation from the Fire Chief. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burden second by Green to approve request to purchase one oxygen cylinder and to send one cylinder to tested and filled, cost for both \$119. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Burden second by Green to approve the fire department members attending a class for CPR certification and pay the cost of \$20.00 per person also to approve firemen to attend a domestic violence class. All present voted yes.

A member from the National Guard was present to request a donation to assist with the Christmas Dinner and gifts for the children. This request was passed until the November meeting.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve the expenditures and financial report. All present voted yes.
