Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve on the first reading of Ordinance No. 105 an ordinance to amend the Jacksboro Zoning Ordinance. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve on the first reading of the 2012-13 budgets for the fiscal year ending 6-30-13. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Forstner to approve appointing Mr. Robert (Bobby) Burrell as the Town of Jacksboro member to the Caryville Jacksboro Utility Commission. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Forstner to approve the CJUC applying for an ARAP for Springfield Subdivision also to approve including East Street and Sharp & Perkins Road in the CJUC Storm water Project. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve a permanent sign permit application. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Forstner second by Green to approve purchase request from the Police Department for installation of equipment by Overbay Communications for the 2012 Charger at the cost of \$945.00 and Street Department to purchase supplies for weed control (\$699.25) and repairs to the backhoe (\$135.00). All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Forstner to authorize the reimbursement of \$500.00 to City Attorney Stephen Hurst for the filing fee to correct the property lines and ownership to the city property located on Cove Street to be used as part of a Recreation Park. All present voted yes.

Motion made by Green second by Forstner to approve the expenditures and financial report. All present voted yes.
